Therapist must wear a visor and a Type II face mask

Face coverings for clients

Face coverings are mandatory for customers visiting: nail, beauty and hair salons; barbers; massage parlours; tattoo and piercing parlours. Face coverings should not be removed unless essential for a particular treatment – for example, for a treatment on the face area covered by the mask.
